

Christian Church Diahton West (Originally Elder Goff's Meeting House) had it's start in 1771/1772 when a number of believers gathered in a barn at Briggs Farm on Old Wellington Street under the leadership of Elder Goff. In 1780 a proper building was completed near the present Rehoboth town line. The present building here was completed in 1796. Since then worship services have continued with only a short time when the church was closed after WWII.

Despite its age, today WDCC is a vibrant growing congregation. Our simple mission is to: Help people find their way back to God and grow in their relationship with God and others We desire to deeply impact our church family with a greater understanding of God's Word and practical its application, motivating us to introduce Jesus to our communities by authentic service without strings attached.
